Guidelines for Internship in 16th Finance Commission

- 1. **Objective:** To familiarize the selected candidates with the process of devolution of finances between the Union and the States in India as well as among the States and also to provide an opportunity to carry out brief research into the specific terms of reference of the 16th Finance Commission, or a key and specific economic issue/problems and offer solutions for the same.
- 2. **Eligibility:** Outstanding Candidates pursuing Graduation (Final year), Post Graduation or PhD in Economics, Finance or similar subjects from leading accredited Universities/Institutions can apply.
- 3. **Attachment:** The interns would be attached with Chairman/Member/Secretary or any other functionary of the 16th Finance Commission.
- 4. **Submission of Paper:** The intern shall also undertake to present an original paper as his/her study report during internship on any research topic.
- 5. **Research Topics:** An indicative list of research topics is at **Annexure-II.** Candidates are required to mention 2-3 specific research topics in their application (in order of preferences) that they wish to study during their internship and for each suggested topic, candidates have to separately provide the following:
 - i. Motivation/vision statement for selection of topics.
 - ii. Proposed outline of study report.
 - iii. Proposed timeline for the project, from zero date till preparation of interim report/submission of final report.
- 6. Application process: Candidates desirous of being appointed as the "interns" in the Commission may forward their application in the duly filled proforma at Annexure-III along with supporting documents in single pdf file, only by e-mail addressed to the Director, 16th Finance commission at <a href="mailto:m
 - "Application for internship in r/o (candidate's name) ".
- 7. Selection: Neatly/legibly filled applications in prescribed format

received through email as stated above will be considered by the Finance Commission for selection. The Commission reserves all rights for offering internship to any candidate and the decision of the Commission shall be final. Internship requests can be refused without assigning any reasons. Eligible candidates whose proposals and competencies for research/study match/suit significantly with 16th Finance Commission's requirements will be given preferences. However, the Commission will finally decide the topic of research for interns, which can be other than those suggested by the candidates.

- 8. **Duration:** The candidate may apply for Internship from 6 weeks to 6 months. However, the duration in each case shall be finally decided by the Finance Commission. Since the time duration is very short, interns would be required to carry out very intense study to ensure desirable outputs in the allotted time frame. During internship, the intern should have minimum 75% attendance.
 - 9. Number of interns: Number of Internship will be limited to a maximum of six(6) paid interns and four(4) additional unpaid interns, selected on merits. Candidates can apply only for one of these options. The candidates applying for both options may not be considered for any of the option.
- 10. **Token remuneration:** Paid interns shall be provided token remuneration of Rs.10,000/- per month per intern for Graduate (Final year)/PG Student and Rs.20,000/- per month per intern for PhD students is payable on satisfactory completion of their internship and on submission of their Report/Paper/Feedback. No other facilities such as DA, perks, allowances, TA/DA, accommodation, conveyance, medical facilities etc would be admissible.
- 11. **Presentation:** Interns may have to make a weekly/fortnightly presentation before his/her assigned Officer. At the end, interns may be required to present a use-case/case-study along with their study report. Any sources, reports referred to in the report/presentation, must be duly disclosed. Due credits be given wherever required.
- 12. Confidentiality & Secrecy: During the period of assignment with the Commission, the "interns" would be subject to the provisions of the Indian Official Secret Act, 1923 and will not divulge any information gathered by them during the period of their assignment to anyone who is not authorized to know the same, at any stage. The "interns" are required to ensure any information gathered related to the Finance Commission or its working is not uploaded or shared on any platform, media/social media, portal, website,

app, AI tool, status, stage or at any other public domain in any form. Any violation of this shall be taken seriously.

- 13. **Integrity certificate:** Interns are required to sign a non-disclosure undertaking and to provide integrity certificate from 2 references before commencing internship.
- 14. **Certification:** Certificates shall be issued to the interns on satisfactory completion of their internship of not less than six weeks and on submission of their Report/Paper and Attendance Certificate duly certified by the Commission's designated Officer.
- 15. **Conditions of Internship:** The internship is neither a job nor any such assurance thereof in the 16th Finance Commission. The interns are expected to maintain decorum and adhere to office working culture. Interns are also expected to maintain integrity and discipline at all times. Interns are expected to approach this opportunity earnestly and adhere to the guidelines diligently. The Intern can be relieved prematurely on ground or unsatisfactory performance or violation of any guidelines or without assigning any reason. The decision of the Commission in this regard shall be final.
